Carelink

Our keynote speaker was Donna from the department of Commonwealth Carelink Service. The CCS is a division of the Department of Health and Aging and provide information to assist older Australians, and people with a disability to remain at home. The network of centres was established in 2001, now there are over 65 'walk-in' centres nationally.

Their office at Chermside covers the geographic region from the Brisbane River north to Gympie, they also co-ordinate activities and delivery with other regions. The office is open normal business hours of 8:30am to 5pm. You should not rely on them in an emergency situation.

They act as a repository of information on who and how to get things done; from home assist with menial chores about the house (light bulb replacement), to tapping into volunteer services that may provide those extra benefits in your life such as driving you to the shops when needed.

Police Report

There are a few items to report on in this newsletter, there have been several reports of prowlers either attempting to break-in or at least gathering intelligence on possible targets.

Recently we have received reports of people being disturbed in the early hours of the morning (3am) by prowlers clambering over the high wooded fences that separate our back yards.

In one case, the resident had secured a large ceramic object that vibrated and made a unique sound so the owner could instantly identify of the sound.

The reported incidents as follows:

Between 9pm and 6am wallet was stolen from a vehicle in the garage. A side door to the garage was unlocked. 26 July, 5am damaged screen door and removed pot plant, then disturbed by occupants. No entry gained. At approximately 5am there was an attempt to enter a residence through the ground level bedroom window, located at the rear of the dwelling. The owner disturbed the offenders who subsequently decamped in a maroon vehicle. There was no entry.

Early in the morning of the 26 July, a resident was woken by a flashlight at window and 2 males attempting to gain entry. The suspects went to a maroon vehicle which was parked on the street and drove away.
