In order to alleviate traffic congestion, the corner of Hamilton and Old Northern Roads will get traffic lights according to state government budget. This follows representations by our NHW group to both local and state government. However, we don't expect to see much work on this until the Hamilton Road upgrade project is finished in early 2008.

Councillor Carol Cashman has recently resigned from Local Council with Councillor Amanda Cooper replacing her until the Council elections in March 2008.

Alderley roundabout upgrade project

Brisbane City Council is replacing the roundabout at the intersection of Raymont Road, Sicklefield Road, Pickering Street and South Pine Road at Alderley. It will be replaced with a four-way signalised intersection.

Project Update—May 2007

New updates to the project include:

- the operation of new traffic signals at the intersection of Sicklefield Road and Shand Street
- road widening to Sicklefield Road and Shand Street
- new parking arrangements introduced along both legs of Sicklefield Road including a 15 minute parking zone directly outside the kindergarten between 6.30am and 6.30pm Monday to Friday

The next stage of the project involves:

- removing the north-west leg of South Pine Road from the intersection
- starting the road and footpath works along South Pine Road, Pickering Street and Raymont Road

Once the north-west leg of South Pine Road has been removed, access to this road will only be available via a left turn from Pickering Street or via Sicklefield Road.

The speed limit has been reduced to 40 km/h and safety barriers are in place to ensure safety.
