What to do ... if your neighbour's house alarm sounds.

Before the alarm sounds, assist your neighbours and give them instructions on what to do. Eg.

- A) call me on my mobile phone.
- B) let me know when I get home.
- C) please phone the Police.

Let your neighbour know if your alarm is monitored.

If you hear an alarm, and see someone, call the police on 000. If you don't see anyone call the Police on 3364 6464 at your earliest convenience. They may send a patrol car to investigate, at least the incident will be recorded.

All alarms should silence within 10 minutes
