Previous Meeting

Over 30 people, including councillor Carol Cashman, attended the last meeting where our state member and Attorney General Rod Welford spoke primarily about traffic concerns.
 In summary:

- The traffic flow through Everton Park has been identified as the main bottleneck.
- The centre parking at Everton Park will be removed with 12 months to accommodate longer turning lanes.
- Commencing in about two years, the Stafford Road / Griffith Street intersection will be aligned, increasing efficiencies in traffic light operation and assisting traffic management.
- Hamilton Road will eventually be connected right through, there is no timeframe assigned.
- Exiting Hamilton Road onto Old Northern Road is becoming a concern, with no immediate plans to resolve.
